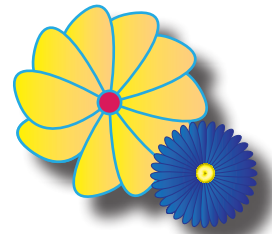
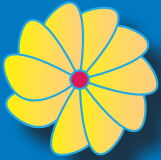

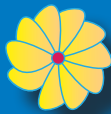

### Danfo UK bucks the trend

Public toilets continue to be a hotly discussed topic in the United Kingdom (see *News from Danfo* 4 2008).

The Daily Mail published a contribution to the ongoing debate by Lucinda Lambton on May 11. This article highlighted Danfo as the solution to problems of accessibility and poor standards of public toilets.

Lambton, who has written several books on public conveniences, praised Danfo's "sensational contributions to our streetscapes".

As an example of a successful strategy for improvement, New Forest District Council's 10-year plan for better public toilets, with Danfo as the preferred supplier, was mentioned (see below for more details).

### Vorsprung durch Technik in Sharjah

The city of Sharjah in the United Arab Emirates has installed a new, fully automatic public toilet from Danfo. The first of several new Danfo installations, the toilet is one of the most technically advanced in the world - and cleans itself automatically after every visit!

Hassan al Taffaq, head of Sharjah's environmental department, hopes that the superior levels of cleanliness will encourage more visitors to use the facility, thus relieving nearby shops and restaurants from spurious toilet visits.

After a period of evaluation, more Danfo toilets will be placed around the city.

### Holidaymaking Toilet Houses

Danfo has delivered two new Toilet Houses to Swedish tourist resort Gotland.

The island of Gotland, with its medieval capital and unique countryside, is in great demand with tourists from all around the world.

Indeed, queues formed outside one of the buildings immediately after the opening ceremony!

## New toilets



The filming location of a number of Swedish costume films, picturesque Stensjö village is a heritage site curated by the Swedish Royal Academy of Letters.

To cater for Stensjö's hordes of tourists, Danfo has recently delivered a fully accessible Toilet House.

The building was designed in co-operation with the Royal Academy to echo the rural turn-of-the-century architecture that makes the village unique.

Sibbarp Park in Sweden's third largest city Malmö has also installed new Danfo toilets.

This Tetragon features a facade of multi-coloured blocks to recall the shades of the surrounding environment.

And with no less than 9 toilet rooms, the building offers ample facilities in this popular site.



Fordingbridge, a town in the South East of England, has recently opened their new Danfo toilet.

Installed as part of New Forest District Council's action plan to improve public toilet facilities, the new building replaced an older, sub-standard installation. Danfo was selected as the preferred supplier because the company offers state-of-the-art facilities designed to fit the local environment.



According to the action plan, New Forest District Council will install a further three public toilets over the next 3 years.
